


New features and improvements

This release will introduce new features and improvements, including:

Kongsberg JDF:


- Griffin now includes the capability of generating Kongsberg JDF files
- The JDF contains additional metadata (number of copies and substrate information, preview and cutting information)
- Full support for configurable PDF preview data, dynamic naming and barcode layering
- New export format allows you to write the zipped JDF file into the iPC submit folder, the file will be automatically consumed and added to the “MyJobs” list for submission to the cutting table





Zund Cut Center 4.0:

- Support for Zund Cut Center for driving workflow directly from Griffin
- Integration now offers full support for version 3.0 and version 4.0 Zund Cut Center
- Integration supports 'Break Changes' in submission data
- Option to select appropriate version level in Griffin configuration, point and press connection (no hot folders)





Stability Improvements:

- Fixed – GN-332 JDK version is causing an error when the user starts Griffin Auto on Mac
- Fixed – GFN-324: Camera marks not outputting to DXF.
- Fixed – GFN-322: Quantity field is not shown when creating Camera Marks
- Fixed – GFN-320: Tiled artwork not showing up correctly in artwork lists

*Upgrade note:

It is important to remove all prior versions of Griffin Auto or Griffin Auto from your system!

- Mac OS users: Drag all instances of the old version(s) to the trash and empty.
- Windows OS users: Use remove programs in Windows to uninstall any previous version.

Version 4 of the Griffin Switch app is required for this upgrade. You can select this new version on the Enfocus Appstore.
