What's new

In the 2349 version, we are introducing a major evolution by merging preflight (job) and image generation (pdf2image) containers and an update to the PitStop 2023 update 1 Library.

1. One Docker container

You no longer need to download and update separate Docker images to get Preflight and Image generation services. The Preflight endpoint (/job) and Image generation endpoint (/pdf2image) will be available from the same container.

2. PitStop 2023 update 1 library

The new 2023 update 1 version of the PitStop Library brings additional features and bug fixes. We kindly invite you to look at the specific release notes here:

Note that some items don't apply to the PLC like the Place PDF tool which is a PitStop Pro only feature, nor the disabling of the Debugging datasets in the PitStop Server configurator in Switch workflows.

3. Skip Font Licence Check

Some fonts may be licensed for View and Print only, so before performing certain font manipulations (e.g. conversion to outlines) PitStop checks if they are allowed by the font provider.

However, you may have an agreement with the font provider, or you may have checked the license conditions and be sure that the requested manipulation is allowed. In that case, you can ask the PLC to skip the font license check.

To skip font license Check, add the following environment variable to your yml file:

```
COM_ENFOCUS_CLOUD_FONT_LICENSE_CHECK
```

Value can be true (by default) to have the PLC check for font license restrictions. Or false if you want the PLC to skip the check. Remember that you are responsible for complying with the font license restrictions!



4. Allow fixes

Preflight profiles can apply fixes when an issue is found. For example, if spot is used, you ask PitStop to convert spot to CMYK. You can now call the allowFixes parameter in your json request to prevent fixes even if they are set in the preflight profile.

5. Authentication token not needed

We would like to remind you that since version 2331 and upwards, the use of an authentication token in the yml file is no longer necessary. If you are still using this parameter in your yml file, you can safely remove it.
