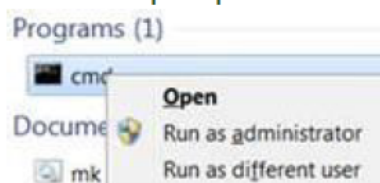


## Instructions for installing the latest LDK RTE Command Line Installer Driver

- Remove any Sentinel Dongle / Key from the machine.
- Download the current version available for the LDK RTE Command line version from the following:

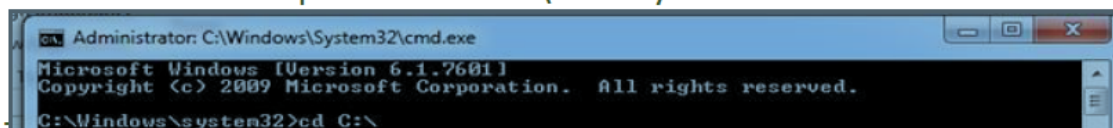
- Extract the zip file (filename: **Sentinel\_LDK\_Run-time\_cmd\_line**)  
Save the installer (filename: **haspdinst.exe**) in the root directory of C:\

- Open command prompt as administrator:



- \* Change the directory and point it to the place you saved the haspdinst.exe installer.

I've saved it in this example on the root of C:\ directory:



- Run the following command to remove every residual file left over from previous installations:

**haspdinst.exe -kp -purge**

- Run the following command to install the LDK RTE (runtime): **haspdinst.exe -i -fi -kp -fss -v -ld**
